He specializes in the treatment of patients with heart failure including cardiac transplantation and left ventricular assist device, cardiogenic shock, pulmonary hypertension, hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, cardiac sarcoidosis, cardiac amyloidosis and OB-GYN patients with high cardiovascular risk.

Dr. Castro also performs right heart catheterizations, endomyocardial biopsies, PA catheter sensor implantations and intra-aortic balloon pump placements, as well as performs and interprets echocardiograms and cardiopulmonary exercise testing.

He works with a collaborative team to provide the critical care necessary for patients with complex heart conditions. Dr. Castro tailors care to meet each patient's goals while also maintaining a holistic approach to health. His goal is always to make a meaningful improvement in the quality and longevity of life for his patients.

Dr. Castro is a member of the American College of Cardiology, and his research interests include cardiac sarcoidosis, pulmonary hypertension and pulmonary artery sensor monitoring.
