She cares for patients living with a variety of diseases and chronic illnesses including diabetes, thyroid, pituitary, bone and adrenal disorders. She treats patient's immediate health challenges and manage their long-term care.

Dr. Rivero enjoys helping solve health problems through science and technology while being a part of the continuity of care. Since many endocrine disorders overlap with other health concerns, Dr. Rivero works closely with other specialists at Memorial including cardiologists, obstetricians for patients with endocrine disorders in pregnancy, endocrine surgeons (for the care of adrenal, parathyroid and surgical thyroid disease), neurosurgeons for the removal of pituitary tumors and the transplant team when caring for patients with endocrine disorders before and after transplants, among others. Her goal is to help patients have the best quality of life within the context of their condition.

In addition to providing patient care, Dr. Rivero is involved in clinical research exploring osteoporosis and future treatment options. She is board certified in Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism Policies and a member of the American Medical Association.

Dr. Rivero has an undergraduate degree in biomedical engineering from Florida International University, where she also earned her medical degree. She completed an Internal Medicine residency at Mount Sinai Medical Center in Miami Beach and fellowship training in endocrinology at University of Florida Health in Jacksonville.
