Jesus C. Fabregas, MD, is a medical oncologist at Memorial Cancer Institute where he specializes in caring for patients with gastrointestinal malignancies, solid tumors and benign hematology cases. He is board certified in Medical Oncology, Hematology and Internal Medicine.

Dr. Fabregas enjoys establishing connections with patients and their families, as he helps them through one of the most difficult times in their lives. He aims to improve patient's quality of life and provide personalized care by accessing the latest targeted and immunotherapy treatments through clinical trials. His recent research endeavors include a meta-analysis studying the feasibility of minimizing toxicities in patients with early rectal cancer, and refining prognosis and treatment selection for patients with early colon cancer applying a machine-learning model.

In addition to medical training, Dr. Fabregas completed his Master of Public Health degree in Epidemiology from Harvard University - Harvard TH Chan School of Public Health. As part of his public health efforts, he evaluated inequities and the impact of social determinants of health in cancer care in the US.

Dr. Fabregas has also published about disparities in patients with pancreatic cancer and presented the results of his research in several oncology society meetings including American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO), American Society of Hematology (ASH) and European Society of Medical Oncology - GI (ESMO-GI). He is also a reviewer for the journal *Frontiers in Oncology*.

Before joining Memorial Cancer Institute, Dr. Fabregas was an assistant professor of medicine in the Division of Hematology Oncology at the University of Florida College of Medicine where he focused on patients with colorectal malignancies.
