Eduardo J. Natal Albelo, MD, is an orthopedic surgeon at Orthopaedic Surgery and Sports Medicine where he specializes in hand and upper extremity surgery and sports medicine. He treats patients with upper extremity conditions from the fingertips to the shoulder. The most common conditions are compressive neuropathies such as carpal and cubital tunnel and stenosing tenosynovitis, better known as trigger finger condition. He also treats hand, wrist and elbow trauma, and patients with shoulder conditions such as rotator cuff tears and instability.

Dr. Natal Albelo sees patients suffering from chronic conditions and those who suffered a life-changing accident, as well as all types of athletes, from professionals to "weekend warriors." No matter their injuries or cause, the goal is always to bring them back to where they were before their ailment.

Medicine, as in sports, is all about the team. Dr. Natal Albelo works closely with the medical staff in the clinic. His goal is to provide patients with an understanding of their condition and the spectrum of treatment options that are available. Fortunately, most hand and wrist conditions can be managed successfully with non-operative options.

In addition to patient care, he also enjoys working with sports teams. As a sports medicine fellow at Inova Hospital, Dr. Natal Albelo was part of the medical staff providing care for multiple professional teams including the Washington Nationals (MLB), DC United (MLS), Washington Spirit (NWSL) and the DC Defenders (XFL). He also had the opportunity to take care of athletes from high school to college levels. His current research interests focus on hand and upper extremity conditions and the impact of socioeconomic factors on patients' outcomes.
